Rain Sleeve

Protect your SLR camera from rain and snow with a protective cover. Compact and easy to stash away for emergency use.



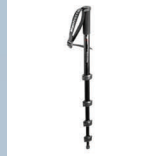
Kata Elements Cover

Monopod

Steady your camera to catch the fast action and night photos. Monopods are easy to carry, easy to use at crowded sports venues where there's limited space to use a tripod.. From \$36.99



Binoculars

Get closer to the action. Whether you're high up in the stadium or watching skiers up the mountain, get in close with a pair of binoculars designed for sports action. Look for high power, long eye relief for easy viewing, image stabilization.



Filters

Protect your expensive lenses. Crowded events can take their toll on your equipment from other spectators or scratches from handling in your gadget bag. Protective filters are inexpensive protection for your expensive lenses, particularly in rough conditions.



Silica gel

Prolonged exposure to moisture and humidity can cause damage to the lens and other camera parts. Beware of packing away your gear after shooting in these conditions. Store your camera with silica gel to eliminate moisture.

Camera bags

Gadget bags, belt-packs, over-the-shoulder sling bags & backpacks. Various sizes & styles. Look for waterproof, well-padded bags. Choose a size that will fit under your seat and not obstruct aisles. Clip on your monopod and you're ready to go. For cold outdoor events, keep your camera warm and dry, possibly inside your jacket when not being used.



Fast telephoto/zoom lens

Sports action calls for fast telephoto lenses. Ideal lenses for sports are in the 200mm to 400mm range with a fast F-stop (i.e. F2.8) so you can get in close and use a faster shutter speed. Image stabilization is beneficial. Not sure which is the right lens for you? Not sure what a fast lens means? Let us help.



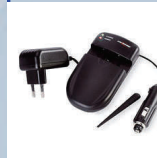
Gorillapod

Get in your own photos or stabilize your camera with a versatile Gorillapod. Wrap it's legs around posts, ski racks, chairs, almost anything. 4 models: compact, SLR, Zoom SLR.



Battery Charger

Left your battery charger at home? A spare charger is also handy for travelling. Universal charger or camera-brand chargers available.



Spare batteries

Batteries hate cold weather. Take at least one spare set of batteries and keep it warm inside your clothing until needed. Don't forget to take fully charged batteries.
